

SCENIC HILLS POOL RULES

THE POOL AREA INCLUDES THE MAIN POOL, SPA, DECK AND ADULT WADING POOL.
THIS AREA IS FOR THE MEMBERS OF SCENIC HILLS ONLY AND THEIR GUESTS.

1. **KEEP IN MIND, THIS IS A POOL BUILT FOR RESIDENTS ONLY 55 AND OVER. IT IS NOT A PUBLIC CHILDREN'S POOL.**
2. All Guests must be accompanied by the sponsoring Resident.
3. There is no lifeguard on duty, therefore, swimming alone is not recommended. Swim at your own risk.
4. Bathing suits are required. No jeans or cutoffs!
5. **Children not potty-trained or any diapered baby or small child are not permitted in the any of the pools. A swim diaper is an indication of not being 100% potty trained. The Resident sponsoring the guest will be responsible for the draining, cleaning and refilling of the Pool in the event of an accident involving untrained children.**
6. Children under 16 years of age may use the pool areas, **unless there is a conflict with a scheduled class or activity** (i.e. Water Aerobics). They must be accompanied by a responsible adult at all times.
7. This is a "NO DIVE POOL". No exceptions. There is no running, jumping, horseplay or diving by anyone using the Pool Area. Jumping from the waterfall is specifically prohibited.
8. Only water soluble sunscreen or lotions are permitted in the pool or spa areas.
9. Bathing caps are required of all swimmers when hair is more than shoulder length.
10. No play toys are allowed in the pool. This includes but is not limited to snorkels, fins, Frisbees, swim boards, rings, balls, coins or rocks.
11. No horseplay is allowed.
12. Follow the rules posted on the sign hanging on the fence.
13. THE SPA IS FOR ADULT USE ONLY!
14. The Pool Area is closed while a class is being conducted.
15. **Food and glass containers are not permitted in the Pool Area. Food and food scraps in the pool end up in the filter and can decompose in the water.**
16. Smoking is prohibited in the Pool and Spa Areas. Smoking is permitted ONLY on the Patio. For consideration of everyone, please dispose of COMPLETELY extinguished cigarette butts and litter into covered trash containers before leaving the area. Ashtray contents can be blown into the pools by occasional high winds and end up in the pool filters.
17. Sun umbrellas must be closed before members and guests leave the area. Please be kind to the equipment and to your neighbors.
18. RESIDENTS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR THE CONDUCT OF THEIR GUESTS AND TO ASSURE ADHERENCE TO ALL THE RULES FOR USE OF THE POOL AREA. VIOLATION OF THE POOL RULES MAY RESULT IN THE LOSS OF USE OF THE POOL BY THE RESIDENT SPONSORING THE GUEST.

THESE RULES ARE MADE FOR THE SAFETY OF ALL USERS OF THE POOL AND FOR YOUR CONTINUED ENJOYMENT FOR MANY YEARS.
