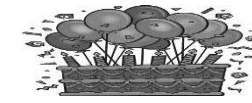

ARTICLE VI SECTION 9, MOTOR VEHICLES AND PARKING, OF THE SCENIC HILLS COVENANTS, ADDRESSES THIS ISSUE. IT STATES "NO VEHICLE SHALL BE PARKED WITHIN THE PROPERTY EXCEPT ON A PAVED PARKING SURFACE, DRIVEWAY OR WITHIN A GARAGE. NO TRUCKS OR VEHICLES WHICH ARE PRIMARILY USED FOR COMMERCIAL PURPOSES, OTHER THAN THOSE TEMPORARILY PRESENT ON BUSINESS, NOR ANY TRAILERS, MAY BE PARKED WITHIN THE PROPERTIES. BOATS, BOAT TRAILERS, CAMPERS, TRAVEL TRAILERS, MOTOR HOMES, RECREATIONAL VEHICLES, AND THE LIKE, MAY BE PRESENT WITHIN THE PROPERTIES FOR PERIODS NOT TO EXCEED SEVENTY-TWO (72) HOURS WITHIN ANY ONE WEEK. PARKED VEHICLES SHALL NOT CONSTITUTE AN OBSTRUCTION TO OTHER TRAFFIC. ANY VEHICLES NOT IN OPERABLE CONDITION OR VALIDLY LICENSED, SHALL ONLY BE PERMITTED TO BE KEPT WITHIN THE PROPERTY IF SUCH IS KEPT INSIDE A GARAGE AND CONCEALED FROM PUBLIC VIEW."

There are not enough words to fully express my heartfelt thanks for the sympathy, love and support you have extended to my family and myself during this time of loss.

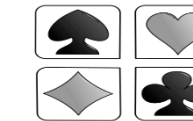

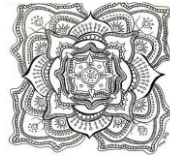

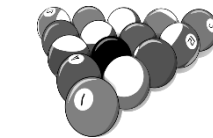


We gather between 6:15 – 6:45 every Wednesday night, depending on when the ‘out to eat’ group returns.
